**WHEREAS**, today we honor our Cold War Veterans and pay special respect to those who made the ultimate sacrifice in the service of our country; and


**WHEREAS**, you fortified our nation through your deeds in the armed forces, your lives and the tales of your bravery continue to inspire others to action.

**THEREFORE**, I, Jeff Harrington, Mayor of the City of Bonner Springs, do hereby proclaim May 1, 2013 as

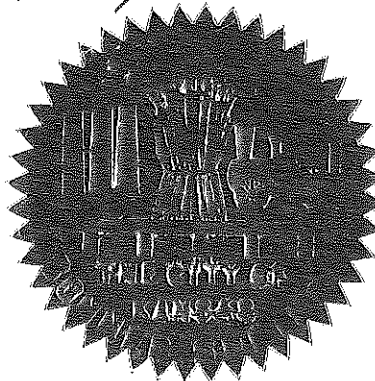
### "Cold War National Day of Remembrance"
